CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION TO GRAND CHOICE

Who can apply?

- Both constituted and non-constituted groups can apply for funding.
- There must be a minimum of three people per group.
- If your group is not constituted, you will need to be sponsored by a constituted group or organisation.
