

² Priority schemes, both whole house and individual measures, are aimed at low-income households. Each of the priority schemes has its own set of vulnerability criteria/income thresholds to identify qualifying households. In general, **NISEP** schemes are targeted at households who do not qualify for assistance from government schemes such as Affordable Warmth or the Boiler Replacement Allowance.
