

Policy For: Fabrication, supply & installation of a new pedestrian lock gate footbridge at the Lagan Valley Island Canal

Why are we doing it?

As recommended in a report produced by The Royal Society for the Prevention of Accidents (ROSPA), to replace the existing pedestrian lock gate footbridge with a new, DDA complaint footbridge with suitable DDA compliant access and egress ramps. It is essential that the existing footbridge is replaced in order to reduce the Health & Safety risks associated with the Lagan Valley Island site.

Who are we doing it for?

The new footbridge at the lock gates will facilitate improved access/egress arrangements for wheelchair users, persons with mobility issues, those using prams / buggies and indeed all other users of the external Lagan Valley Island site.

Benefits?

Health & safety risks on the Lagan Valley Island will be reduced, plus access/egress arrangements on the site will be improved.
