Policy For: Installation of 'rumble strips' and new pedestrian pathways on the Lagan Valley Island Site

Why are we doing it?

As recommended in a report produced by The Royal Society for the Prevention of Accidents (ROSPA), to reduce health & safety risks on the external Lagan Valley Island Site by installing rumble strips to act as a traffic calming measure, and new pathways to improve pedestrian / vehicle segregation.

Who are we doing it for?

For all users of the Lagan Valley Island building & external site – staff, visitors, customers and patrons – to provide improved and safer access (in particular, those with mobility issues including wheelchair users, those with young children who require the use of prams/buggies, & older persons)

Benefits?

The policy will provide safer and more convenient access / egress arrangements for the Lagan Valley Island site
