What should I put in my landfill bin?

Most of the waste materials from your home should be disposed of through your recycling service or brown bin. There are some household materials that cannot be recycled or composted through your household collection and they should be placed in your landfill bin. These include:

- Air fresheners
- Biscuit wrappers / sweet wrappers
- Bubble wrap and padded envelopes
- Cable ties
- CDs/DVDs
- Ceramics
- Cigarette butts
- Cling film
- Clothes hangers (plastic, wooden or metal)
- Cork
- Cotton buds
- Crisp packets
- Disposable cups
- Disposable nappies / razors
- Elastic bands
- Greaseproof paper
- Hot water bottles
- Latex gloves
- Pet food pouches
- Pill packets
- Plant pots
- Plastic bags (bread bags, cereal box liners, sandwich bags, biodegradable bags)
- Plastic film
- Plastic straws
- Polystyrene (cups, food packaging, packing peanuts)
- Sanitary products
- Sponges
- Tinsel
- Toothpaste / handwash pumps / toothpaste tubes
- Wallpaper
- Wipes – cleaning / face / baby
- Wire / cables
- Wrapping paper (foil or glittery)
