

COVID-19 TEMPORARY COLLECTION MEASURES

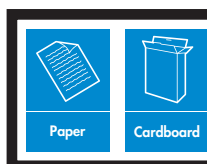


Bryson Recycling provides an essential service in removing recyclable waste from households and we are committed to deliver this service is the safest way possible through the Covid-19 pandemic.

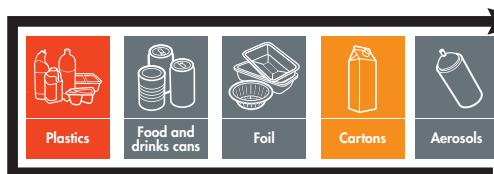
In order to reduce the hand sorting of materials by our staff can you please sort your recycling materials in the following way:

ONLY these materials can go in each box:

Option 2



Option 3



If you only have 2 boxes please rotate the materials you present each week, for example put out paper and cardboard out one week, and glass the next week.

If materials are not sorted in this way, boxes will not be emptied.

Sorry, but we can't collect batteries, textiles or hand tools at this time.

Overflow bags will not be accepted at this time.

Help us protect our staff, your neighbours, and your family by taking the following steps:

- Please **wash hands before and after** leaving your recycling out and taking your boxes back in.
- Please **wash your hands before putting items** in your boxes.
- Please **disinfect the handles/flaps** of your boxes before and after putting out your recycling.
- If anyone in your house has symptoms of COVID-19, please **avoid putting boxes out for 72 hours** after the two week self-isolation period.
- **Do not put recycling out while you are self-isolating.**
